We know there continues to be a lot of online class offerings to select from these days and we have tried our best to offer a variety of styles. The most important difference is our goal is to ensure our retreat classes are affordable for all. Please spread the word.

Online registration has already begun.

Payment processing - We use PayPal and accept credit cards. ArtRoom2Create will appear as the paid party on your credit card/bank statement.

WHAT MAKES THIS ONLINE RETREAT DIFFERENT FROM OTHER ONLINE CONVENTIONS?

1. **No registration fees.**
2. For the classes that you registered to take, you will have access to class recordings for a period of 6 months. We ask that you be respectful of our teachers and not share the class recordings with others. This access is a gift that the retreat teachers are graciously offering and, if it is abused, the teacher reserves the right to rescind this privilege.
3. Truly an interactive event, we have one Zoom classroom rule and that is to be respectful of others. We affectionately call this a courtesy. You will have the capability to independently unmute yourselves to ask your questions? However, before you ask your question, we simply ask you to allow the teacher to finish speaking and not interrupt her or other class participants.

Before you register for classes there are a few disclosures we need to share.

1. Once you have registered for a class, there will be no refunds issued.
2. Class registrations can only be completed on the ArtRoom2Create Website <https://artroom2create.com/>. A special tab on the website has been created to identify where you can register for retreat classes, it has been labeled (May Retreat).
3. Please do not double-book yourself and expect a refund because this will not happen. Once the teacher's packet is made available to you, "we" are responsible for paying the teacher a contractual fee, thus the reason for a no refund policy.
4. Only in the event a teacher cancels will you be issued a refund for the class fee.
5. Most e-packet class information will be downloadable once you receive the shipment confirmation email. If you have any problems, please send an email to artroom2create@gmail.com

2. High-speed internet service is recommended.
3. Please test your equipment to make sure your camera and speaker function.
4. Please familiarize yourself with the mechanics of Zoom. Do you know how to mute yourself, use the chat feature, rename yourself, etc.?
5. You will only be allowed to sign into the classroom with one device.
6. We will be offering a few test sessions in May so you can confirm you connect to Zoom. This information will be emailed to all registered attendees on May 1st.

Okay, now that we have addressed the meat, let us get to the potatoes.

We can provide you with the timeslots for the classes. PLEASE NOTE ALL TIMES ARE EASTERN TIME.

Thursday, May 16th, Friday, May 17th, Saturday, May 18th, and Sunday, May 17th

The first class, each day starts at 10:00 AM and ends at 2:00 PM Eastern Time. The second class starts at 3:00 PM and ends at 7:00 PM Eastern Time.

The third class starts at 8:00 PM and ends at 10:00 PM Eastern Time.

A skill level has been indicated in the class description to assist you in selecting classes that match your comfort level. Beginner classes are taught at a slower pace, intermediate classes are taught at a moderate pace, and advanced classes are taught at a faster pace.

Retreat Class Fees:

The 4-hour class fee is \$40.00. The fee includes access to the Zoom room, teacher's virtual instruction, and complete e-packet (prep instructions, supply list, line drawing, picture(s), completion instructions) and, if applicable/approved, the post-class recording access.

It is the student's responsibility to provide a surface on their own. If the surface is only available through the teacher or others, the teacher's supply list will include that information.

Due to the generosity of many of our teachers and businesses in the industry, we are pleased to announce prizes will be offered throughout the retreat weekend. Our Zoom monitors will make sure they capture the names of the winners, and we will contact you.
